Threes:

Social and Emotional:

1. Beginning to negotiate and solve problems with words
2. Able to wait for a turn
3. Plays interactively with other children
4. Able to make independent choices
5. Able to handle problems appropriately
6. Respects the needs of others and self
7. Able to handle minor disappointments
8. Able to separate from parents easily

Physical:

1. Able to toilet independently
2. Able to dress independently and attend to cubby
3. Able to run without falling
4. Uses crayons and markers with ease
5. Able to manipulate scissors effectively
6. Able to go up and down stairs with ease
7. Works on jumping, running, throwing
8. Beginning to pump on swings without help

Cognitive:

1. Able to follow a two step direction
2. Able to sit and participate in a large group for 15 minutes
3. Able to follow class rules and routines
4. Able to count three or more objects when asked how many
5. Able to recognize the primary and secondary colors
6. Able to identify the four basic shapes
7. Able to recognize own name in print
8. Able to put toys away in their proper place
9. Understands the concepts of alike and different
10. Working on concepts such as up and down, behind and in front, and in and out
11. Able to identify body parts
12. Begins recognizing rhyming words

Creative:

1. Self-expression through the use of paints, clay, crayons, and other materials
2. Using props for dramatic play and creative expression
3. Responds rhythmically to songs, singing, moving, and listening to music
4. Explores sounds with basic rhythm instruments
5. Retells simple stories through dramatizations
