Preschool Schedule

A typical day in our weekday Preschool program

Each day brings new experiences here at Winfree Preschool. Please find below a snap shot of a typical day.

Learning Centers are open throughout most of the morning/ Teacher directed small group activities (structured activities which promote learning skills in sensory, fine motor, cognitive, art, music and movement, language arts, science, math, etc) Individual activities/exploration of materials

- Weekly themes: individuality, self awareness, beginning to take responsibility
- Spiritual Curriculum: provides opportunities for each child to learn about God's world and how to live in it. Unit and themes are designed to help lay a foundation for understanding God, Jesus, the Bible, the church, self, community and world, and creation.
- Kindness curriculum: feelings, sharing, caring
- Social development: interacting with peers and adults, conflict resolution, expression of feelings
- Language and listening: language development, letter and sound recognition, phonics
- Reading and writing: letters of the alphabet and phonics, name recognition
- Math: count orally, numbers, shapes, sorting, matching
- Large and fine motor skills: body awareness, coordination, directional awareness, music
 and movement
- Science: sensory and discovery
- Arts and crafts: use different art media with painting and three dimensional art
- Music throughout the day: a balance of music and movement, percussion instruments,
 sound and pattern reproduction, lessons are a minimum of one time per week
- Spanish curriculum: an understanding of additional languages, vocabulary, greetings, songs and stories lessons are integrated into the program daily.
- A wide variety of supplemental educational programs are invited into the program
 throughout the school year, including monthly chapel with our Children's Minister.
- Visits from the Preschool Director to share story time and songs. This allows children the
 opportunity to respond to storytelling, sequence events in the story, and use of illustration
 in storytelling.
