

## 2024-2025 Programs

### **Toddler Program-**

This program consists of a two-day class that meets on Tuesdays/Thursdays and a three-day class that meets Mondays/Wednesdays/Fridays each week from 9-12. Children eligible for the two-day class must be 16 months old by September 3<sup>rd</sup>. Children eligible for the three-day class must be 18 months old by September 3<sup>rd</sup>. The student to teacher ratio is 5:2 for both programs. Children do not need to be potty trained for this class.

### **Two-year-old Program-**

This program consists of a two-day class that meets on Tuesdays/Thursdays and a three-day class that meets Mondays/Wednesdays/Fridays each week from 9-12. Children eligible for these classes must be 2 years old by September 3<sup>rd</sup>. The student to teacher ratio is 12:2 for both programs. Children do not need to be potty trained for this class.

### **Three-year-old Program-**

#### **Younger Class**

This program consists of a two-day class that meets on Tuesdays/Thursdays and a three-day class that meets Mondays/Wednesdays/Fridays each week from 9:10-12:10. Children eligible for these classes must be 3 years old by September 30. The student to teacher ratio is 12:2 for both programs. Children do not need to be potty trained for this class.

#### **Older Class**

This program consists of a two-day class that meets on Tuesdays/Thursdays and a three-day class that meets Mondays/Wednesdays/Fridays each week from 9:10-12:10. Children eligible for these classes must be 3.5 years old by September 30. The student to teacher ratio is 15:2 for both programs. Children need to be potty trained for this class.

### **Four-Year-Old Program-**

The four-year-old programs develop both social and academic school readiness skills needed to be successful in kindergarten. The teachers introduce specific activities that help the children to develop cognitively, socially, emotionally, physically, and spiritually through play-based learning centers as well as teacher directed activities.

#### **2-day class**

This program meets Tuesdays/Thursdays each week from 9:10-2:00. Children eligible for this class must be 4 years old by September 30. The student to teacher ratio is 18:2. Children need to be potty trained for this class. Students will bring lunch to eat during the school day.

#### **3-day class**

This program meets Mondays/Wednesdays/Fridays each week from 9:10-12:10. Children eligible for this class must be 4 years old by September 30. The student to teacher ratio is 18:2. Children need to be potty trained for this class.

#### **5-day class**

This program meets Mondays-Fridays each week from 9:10-12:10. Children eligible for this class must be 4 years old by September 30. The student to teacher ratio is 18:2. Children need to be potty trained for this class.

**5-day Extended Day**

This program meets Mondays-Fridays each week from 9:10-1:30. Children eligible for this class must be 4 years old by September 30. The student to teacher ratio is 18:2. Children need to be potty trained for this class.

Students will bring lunch to eat during the school day.

The Extended Day Fours program is a unique combination of the traditional fours class and the JK program. With an extended day, we prepare older four-year-olds for the rigor of the kindergarten day by including lunch in our program. We start the year as a fully play based fours program with a strong emphasis on social and emotional skills but as the students mature and grow from their additional classroom time, when we return from Christmas break in January, we begin to introduce JK components such as more complex fine motor work, encouraging more advanced literacy, math and writing skills and challenges, as well as, longer group times that more closely mirror the traditional JK class.

**Junior Kindergarten Program**

This program meets Mondays-Fridays each week from 9:10-1:30. Children eligible for this class must turn 5 before October 1. The student to teacher ratio is 15:2. Children need to be potty trained for this class. Students should have attended a 4-year-old class the prior year. Students will bring lunch to eat during the school day.

**Extra Programs-****Early Care Program-**

This program is designed to be flexible around your child's schedule running from 7:30-9:10. This is an additional contracted program for the school year, the days you register for will need to be consistent each week. This is a mixed age group of students that range from 3-5. Parents may bring a small breakfast snack for the child to have if they arrive prior to 8:30. The student to teacher ratio based on the age of the youngest child registered.

**Extended Care Program-**

This program is designed to be flexible around your child's schedule running from 12:15-5. This is an additional contracted program for the school year, the days you register for will need to be consistent each week. We offer 2 pick up by dismissal times, 3:30 and 5:00. This is a mixed age group of students. Students will continue to explore, play, and engage in fun activities. All students will have a 1-1.25-hour quiet rest time. The students staying after the 3:30 pick up will be provided a USDA approved snack by Winfree Memorial Preschool. Students will bring lunch to eat and a small blanket for rest time. The student to teacher ratio based on the age of the youngest child registered.

**Lucky Lunch-**

This program is designed to be flexible around your child's schedule, running from 12:15-1:30. Students enrolled in the Three-year-old programs and up will have the opportunity to register to stay past dismissal time to enjoy lunch and additional social interactions with other students. Parents will provide an allergy friendly lunch. This is a mixed age group of students that range from 3-5. This program is a perfect bridge for our enrichment programs that start at 1:30 throughout the year. The student to teacher ratio based on the age of the youngest child registered.
