# The following will be taught and assessed during the year

Twos:

#### **Social Emotional**

- Separates from family, being comfortable and having fun
- Playing and interacting with others/learn to function as part of a group
- Learn to follow routines, circle time, help clean up
- Learn to follow directions
- Gain independence in self help
- Listen attentively to stories
- Begin playing with other children fairly
- Problem solving
- Verbally communicate needs and wants
- Separates from family easily
- Accepting the rights and choices of others
- Using language and sensitivity to children (negotiating and problem solving)
- Learning to wait for short periods

# **Emotional**:

- Naming and accepting feelings and the appropriate expression of them
- Abiding by classroom rules and expectations
- Becoming independent and self-sufficient
- Recognizing individuality through choices

# **Cognitive:**

- Focusing on the activity at hand
- Observing and naming the world around them- textures, sounds, weather, etc.
- Developing a love of books

- Creative play and problem-solving
- Recognizing likeness and differences

# Math

- Recognize shares: circle square, triangle, rectangle
- Count from 1-10 or more
- Order objects by size big, small
- Sort objects
- Begin to understand one to one correspondence

# **Creative Arts**

- Drawing, tearing, pasting, painting
- Experiment with a variety of art mediums: paint, glue, finger paints
- Begin to use creativity in art
- Learn simple songs
- Do rhythmic activities
- Act out familiar stories and songs
- Demonstrate feelings through body movements
- Use imagination
- Responding rhythmically to music of different styles and tempos
- Exploring sounds of basic rhythm instruments

# **Motor development**

- Gross-gain general coordination of movement: run, jump, walk up and down stairs, kick ball
- Learn toileting control
- Fine scribble, draw lines and circles, string large beads, stack objects

# Science

- Become aware of surrounding environment through investigation
- Recognize seasonal changes
- Learn about different animals
- Learn about good nutrition, dental health, safety

# **Social studies**

- Learn about families and customs
- Become aware of different cultures
- Learn about community helpers
